SOME FACTS:

- * \$41-136T transferred in next 50 years
- * Some churches and denominations funded largely by estate gifts
- * 4 of 5 wealthy people leave no gifts to charity
- * Only 15% of churches received estate gifts last year





SOME FACTS:

- * Ditch the jargon Estate Gifts, not Planned Giving
- * A church or school can only receive a gift through a will
- * 50% of people don't have wills





SO, WHAT CAN WE DO TO ENCOURAGE ESTATE GIFTS?





1. LEGAL NAME(S) IN ALL YOUR COMMUNICATIONS

- * Church, school, endowment...
- * Standing box
- * With estate thought



2. ESTATE PLANNING WORKSHOPS



- * Invites to all church members
- * Refreshments
- * Pastor, principal, accountant, lawyer, financial rep
- * Pastor or principal opens and closes
- * Pastor or principal makes case for church or school at the end





3. EASY THOUGHT:

- * Think of church as one of your children
- * If you have three kids, think of church as your fourth



4. PREACH ESTATE BEQUEST WEEKEND!

- * At end of stewardship renewal
- * Time in prayer, talent in ministry & involvement, treasure in INCOME (Now) and ASSETS (Later)
- * Most people afraid of outliving income
- * Estate Gift is good stewardship of assets








5. FORM A LEGACY SOCIETY

- * Return postcards to all who've left church or school in their will
- * Yearly lunches or dinners
- * Yearly thank yous
- * Publicize members



6. MAIL OUT ESTATE BROCHURES



- * Letter from pastor
- * Legal titles mentioned
- * Brochures with your logo
- * Include postcard for those requesting more info





7. ANNOUNCE BEQUESTS

- * From pulpit
- * At meetings
- * In bulletins, newsletters, websites



8. FIVE WAYS TO ACKNOWLEDGE



- * Handwritten note to family
- * Apply gift specifically, not to general fund
- * Label gift hymn books, pews, organ...
- * Hold a dedication service
- * Observe anniversaries scholarships, grants...
