St. Wenceslaus has a long and proud history of sharing and living our Catholic faith. Originally founded in 1877 and relocated to West Omaha in 1980, it has grown to more than **3,200 households** in our church family, **900 students** in our school, and **400 children and adults** in our religious education programs. Approximately 3,500 parishioners and guests currently celebrate at one of our seven Masses each weekend.

With continued growth projected in the future, we're so grateful that our new church will accommodate more than 1,400 people, and serve as the spiritual home for future generations. But this major investment in the life of our parish comes with a price tag that is too big to overcome without a capital campaign.

The **ELEVATE** campaign aims to accomplish the following financial goals:

GOAL #1: Celebration \$5M

Challenge \$8M

GOAL #2:

If we reach the goal of \$5 million, we will save \$2,630,000 in interest. If we reach the goal of \$8 million, we will save \$4,481,000 in interest. **\$12M** If we reach the goal of \$12 million, we will save \$6,949,000

If we reach the goal of \$16 million, we will save \$7,566,000 in interest.

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS ABOUT THE ELEVATE CAMPAIGN

Q: Why is St. Wenceslaus building a new church and expanding its campus?

- A: When the St. Wenceslaus Planning and Leadership teams evaluated the need for expansion, the following were the deciding factors to go forward:
 - The land on either side of Pacific Street is estimated to bring in an additional 1,250 households (4,500 people) to our community in the next 10 years.
 - With a decline in active priests in the Archdiocese, St. Wenceslaus will likely be assigned only 1^{1/2} priests by 2030. This will directly impact how many Masses will be offered.
 - We currently have only a few meeting rooms available for our parish groups and ministries. With new parish offices and a renovation of our current offices, we can expand our ministry outreach and offer more meeting spaces.
 - The cost of construction goes up an average of 4% every year. In 2015, it was decided to expand our current campus with a school addition and a new parish church and offices to save on these rising costs.
 - A campus vision, master plan, capital campaigns, and bank loans will allow St. Wenceslaus to properly meet its growing needs in a more planned and financially responsible way.

Q: Will all of the money raised stay here to fund the needs of St. Wenceslaus?

A: Yes, 100% of the donations pledged during the **ELEVATE** campaign will be used toward our building loans.

Q: Didn't we just have a capital campaign?

A: Yes, our *Building In Faith For Future Generations* concluded in 2018. Here is an overview of our current financial picture as it relates to funds raised and funds needed:
